What is the Planet Registry and Planet App and why is it so important?

The PLANET Registry is the first dedicated registry for neuroendocrine cancers internationally and we want to ensure that this registry is successful.

A data repository for clinical information for patients with neuroendocrine tumours it is designed to facilitate the exchange of information about NET patients between clinical professionals, and provides mechanisms to collect valuable information for research, and further studies.

It is so important that we can collect detailed and comprehensive data about each patient so that we can truly understand the types of NETs, diagnostic tools, demographics, treatment options, treatment outcomes, side effect management and involve patients in Clinical Trials and tailor trials to improve the lives of NET patients.

To download the PLANET app for iOS:



- ✓ Go to the App Store and search for "PLANET medical"
- Click on "install" and wait until the "PLANET" icon appears on your device
- ✓ Tap the icon to open the app then enter your activation code provided by your clinician (App ID)
- Click on "activate" and you have successfully connected your device to the study

To download the PLANET app for Android:



- ✓ Go to Google Play and search for "PLANET neuroendocrine"
- Click on "install" and wait until the "PLANET" icon appears on your device
- Tap the icon to open the app then enter your activation code provided by your clinician (App ID)
- Click on "activate" and you have successfully connected your device to the study
