



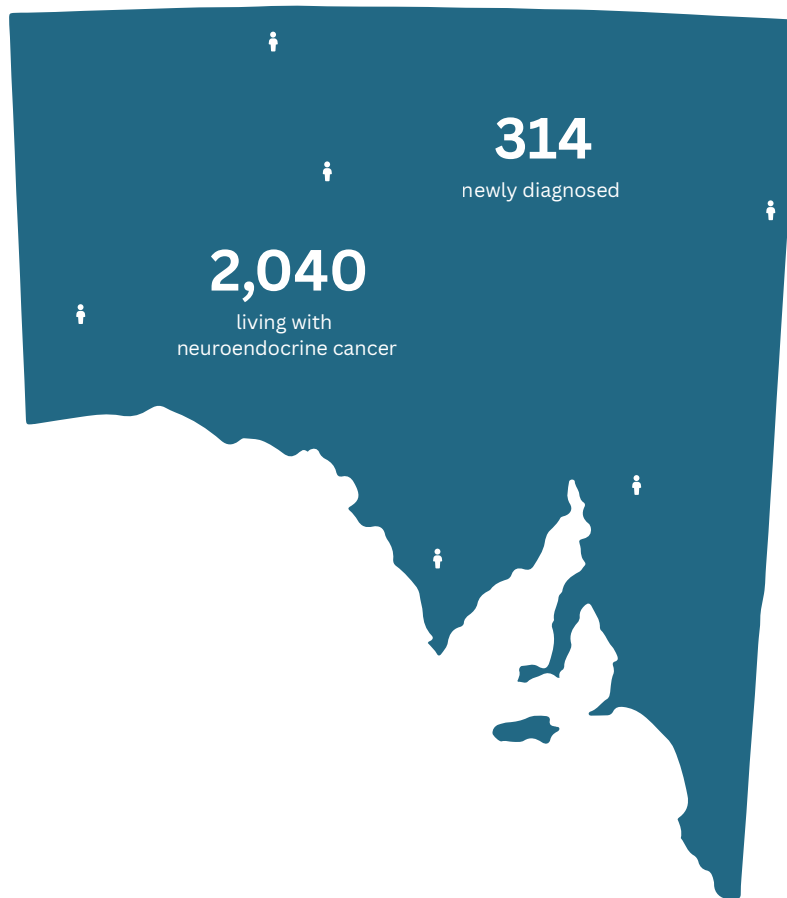

In SA alone our NET patients make up 9% of all calls to the specialist NET Nurse line, making 458 contacts in the last year alone
